Dear Fellow Republican:

The elections for Ithacs echool board candidates and the public referendum on the school board budget are vary important. School tax levies are the largest taxes many of us pay, yet in recent years our school board has been dominated by free spenders. Moreover, many board members have views on the curriculum and other issues that differ from those of most Republicans.

I personally urge you to vote on Tucsday, May 18th for Allen Lambert for the Ithaca Board of Education as the candidate with the most fiscally-sound views. Please consider voting only for Lambert, as casting ballots for multiple candidates dilutes our voting power.

Please note that some polling places differ from the general elections and hours are limited. Separately, on the ICSD budget, outgoing ICSD Board member and good Republican Henry Kramer has recommended a NO vote. The budget proposal contains some wasteful spending and distorted priorities and if defeated will be returned to the ICSD Board of Education for reworking and submission to a new vote.

Please go to the polls on May 18th. Let the voice of Republicans be heard!
